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Dashboards – Where Do I Start?

- Think about your users accessing the dashboard:
 - What is it they need to see right now?
 - How can I keep from getting things cluttered?
 - 3 clicks to content
- How can I make it easy to use?
- Are the users technical or not?
- Website friendly
- One task per dashboard (if possible for operations)

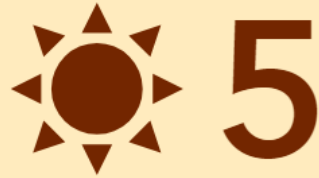

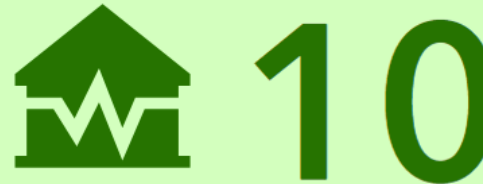

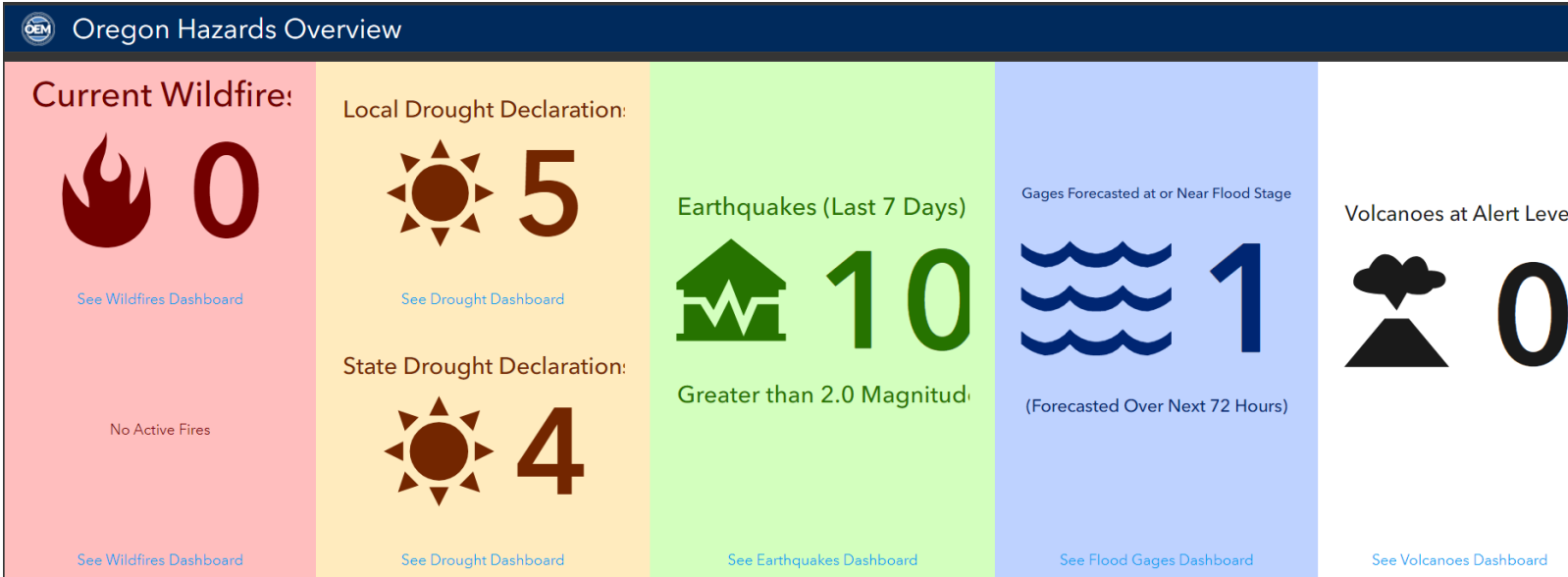

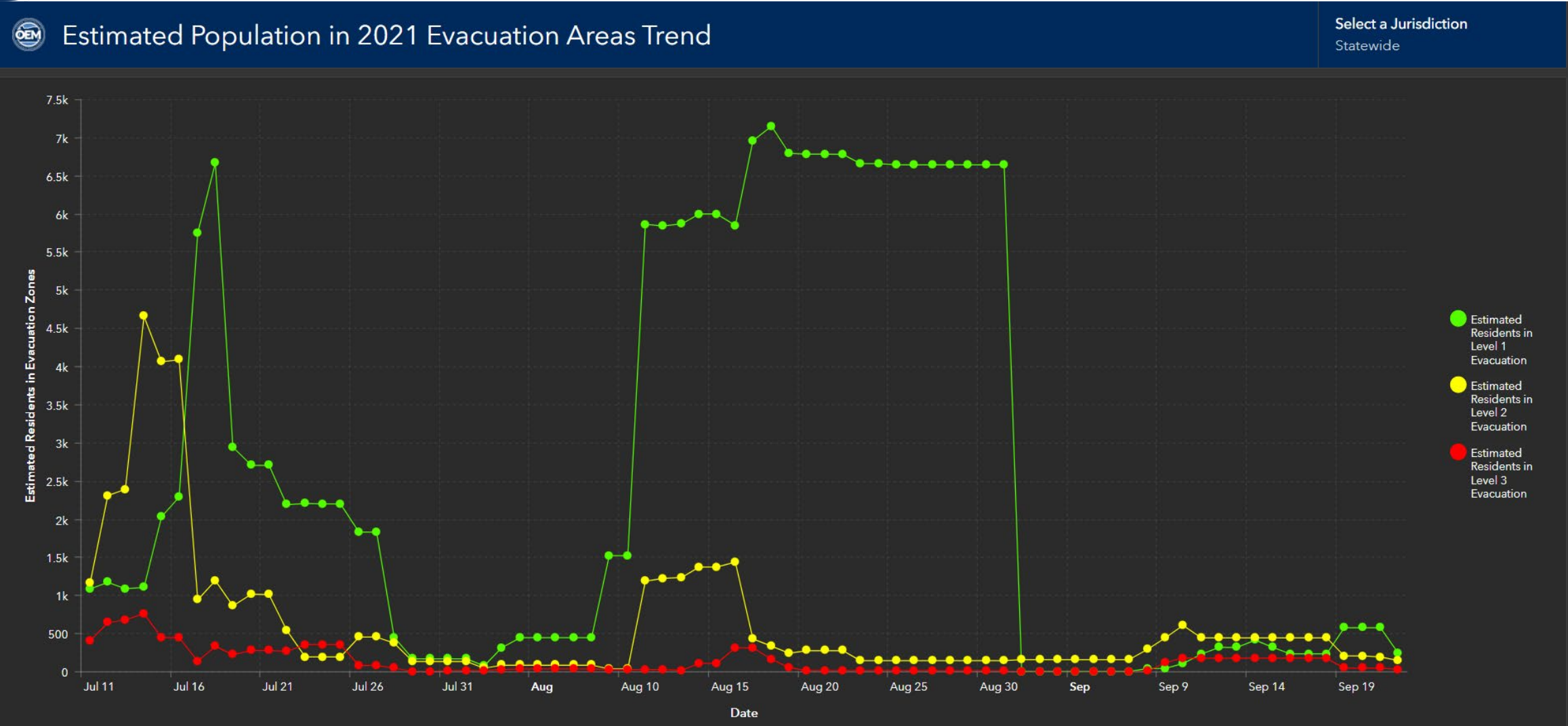

How To Use This Dashboard

Click on the record on the list on the left side of the screen to open the form record in the second panel.

This will display the record information collected from the submitted form (either from QuickCapture or Survey123).

To determine address information for QuickCapture collected data, you can click on the "Recalculate" button under any location field to calculate an estimated address for that location. These fields can be updated as necessary after this process to ensure it reflects the proper address and location information.

Next, update any other text and information as necessary, then change the QA/QC Reviewed field to "Yes" to indicate the record has been reviewed and approved for your jurisdiction. Then hit the "Submit" button to finalize the updates for the record. Completed records will display as a green

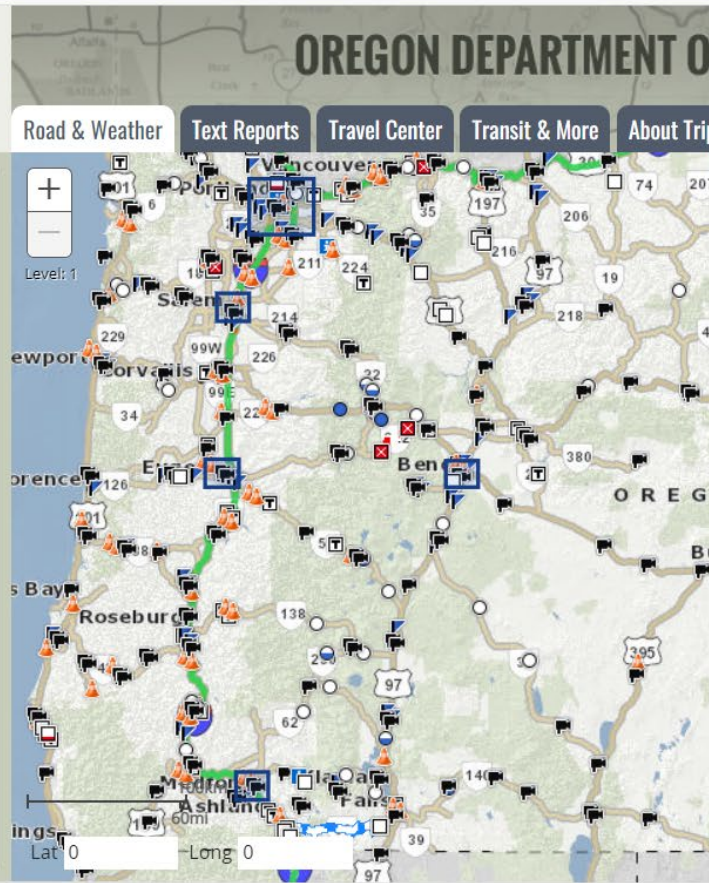

 - Can make different URLs for your dashboard to filter data by default
 - Helpful when you have multiple dashboards needing default filtering



Trick of the Trade – Other Sneaky Ones You May Have Missed

- URL Matters when embedding for external partners!

- Data Settings (for refresh)
 - Refresh interval in webmap ties to how often the data refreshes in your widgets
- Source Data Downloads

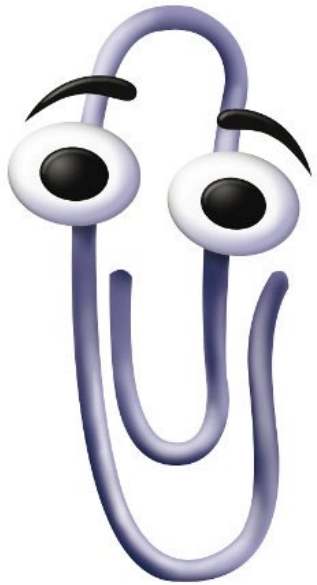


- Any easy way to edit
