Gail convened the meeting, and we all introduced ourselves.

- 1. Design and status of zoning and comprehensive plan project
- 2. UGB Stewardship Plan comments and next steps

UGB Stewardship Plan was taken up first on request. Gail explained the simple stewardship plan and the mechanism for keeping it current. She also described the continuing process of working with cities to improve the line work and fill in gaps. Angela Lazarean has done a great job getting UGB data this far, and Robert Mansolillo is taking on this responsibility. DLCD publishes an annual version with the most current boundaries only. It also has a geodatabase of all the historic boundaries. The attributes are attached to line segments. DLCD will publish this version soon.

The UGB stewardship plan comment period has closed. We received one comment. Gail plans to respond one-on-one since there are many aspects to the comment. The comment does not materially change the plan, so it can proceed to the next step in the approval process with some additional clarifying material.

Design and status of the Zoning and Comprehensive Plan Framework Pilot

Gail described the burgeoning collaboration among several partners. The DLCD outreach team is already deployed and bringing in data and requests for data development. ODOT has a contractor selected for processing data into Framework data. Robert Mansolillo will act as the technical glue to connect between outreach and ODOT/GIS contractor. In eastern Oregon, Eastern Oregon University interns will be developing data where none exists, and GEO's Dave Snader will be managing the team of interns and checking their work before forwarding it to Robert. LCOG will be developing data where none exists in the other parts of Oregon.

The results of contacts via AGOL map service are available for anyone to look at. See the link on our Planning WG page, under Admin Bnd FIT. The emerging statewide data will be published on a Web service. The initial area of focus will be the Willamette Valley, due to ODOT priorities. This is an exciting partnership for all involved. Due to the intensity of the activities happening on the project, the next meeting will be after the end of the biennium, in July or August.
