



Accomplished:

- ✓ Orientation workshop for public body consultation on data sharing
- ✓ OGIC representatives have begun the consultation process

Ongoing:

- Consultations are underway with 12 agencies (Group 1)
- Consultation processes will continue to completion
- DSC will present completed data elements to OGIC for endorsement (in July for Group 1)





Update: Legislative Coordination

Ongoing Efforts:

- Discussion of the OGIC/GEO 2025-2027 Policy Option Package
- Discussion and Review of Bills under consideration in the short session
- Working on talking points and materials for meetings with legislators in preparation for the long session in 2025
- Reviewed the OGIC performance measures that are aligned with the Legislative Coordination Committee (LCC) and determined who the measure owners will be
