- EmPOWER Database database of medical life sustaining devices that require power. https://empowerprogram.hhs.gov/
 - Need to cross-check database in case of conflicts in prep for pre-determined fire-related power shutdowns
- Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) data:
 - o https://portlandgeneral.com/psps-info
 - PGE and power companies are likely to already have relationships with power companies.
 - Rate of change is unknown. May be possible for an analysis to be one prior to fire season if database is stable enough.
- Resources from Emergency Management GIS Interest Group (EMGIG) <u>data collection</u> include PSPS data from Portland General Electric (PGE), Pacific Corp, and Consumers Power Incorporated (CPI).
