Framework:

Bob Denouden: Today GPL will review the ten Framework data development funding proposals that were submitted. Earlier, the reviewing team, comprised of Bob Denouden, Cy Smith, Gail Ewart, Phil McClellan, and Diana Walker, met to conduct a high level review of the proposals, This morning the FIT leads provided their input on how the proposal address/promote Framework. For the GPL review, we will now focus on the <u>technical merit</u> of the proposals. Bob D highlighted the FIT leads recommendations.

<u>Framework summary perspective</u>: -There were two proposals which were not endorsed, and one proposal had its funding amount slightly reduced:

- LIDAR data distribution the approach could not be supported. The proposers should first look at Federal efforts, such as the Army Corps, that provide access to lidar data. DOGAMI should work with Elevation FIT to help find a workable solution.
- OWERS (Or Watershed Emergency Response System) project is valuable but the funding source is not appropriate. FIT Leads felt that the project is not fully developed yet.
- Historical Railroad proposal requested amount was reduced by a small amount in order to fit within the \$500,000 total funding.

<u>GPL perspective</u>: - Since there was only an hour available to conduct the review, GPL first focused on projects that were unanimously endorsed by the reviewer team and by the Framework FIT Leads. GPL then discussed proposals which were not supported or had other issues. Listed below in the right hand column of the table is the outcome of the GPL review:

GIS Red Cross Training in Africa

Emmor Nile – Invited by the American Red Cross to travel to East Africa to train local Red Cross volunteers in the use of mapping and GPS. The training focused on the use of Open StreetMap (OSM), with a tasking in Humanitarian OSM Team (HOT) to establish baseline maps for community resiliency in Geita District, Tanzania.

The field portion of the training utilized an Android application (Open MapKit) to capture feature attributes supplemented with additional information using FieldPapers. The FieldPapers website automatically georeferences images of the annotated sheets which are then used as a reference in JOSM to update OSM.
