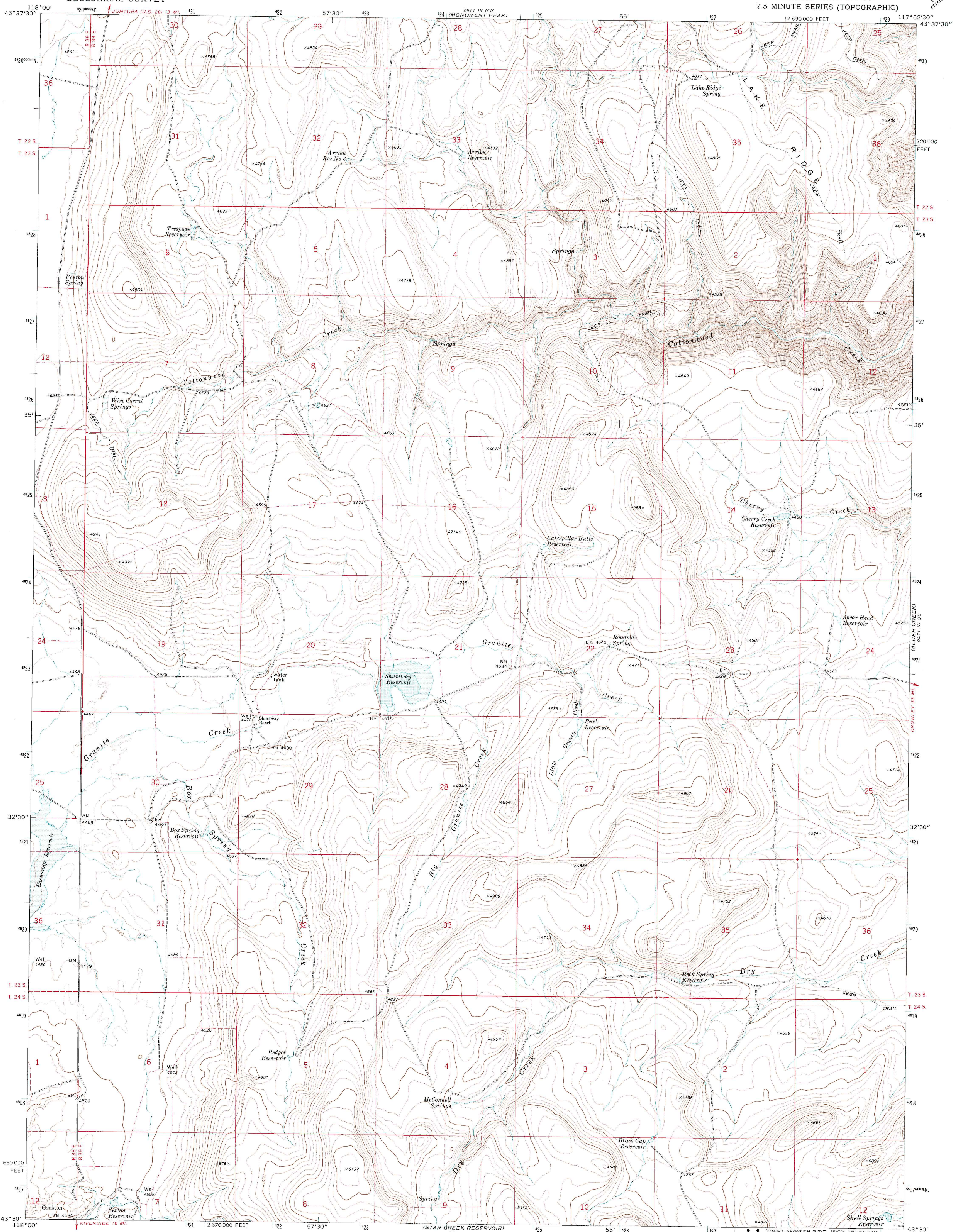

system, south zone (Lambert conformal conic)

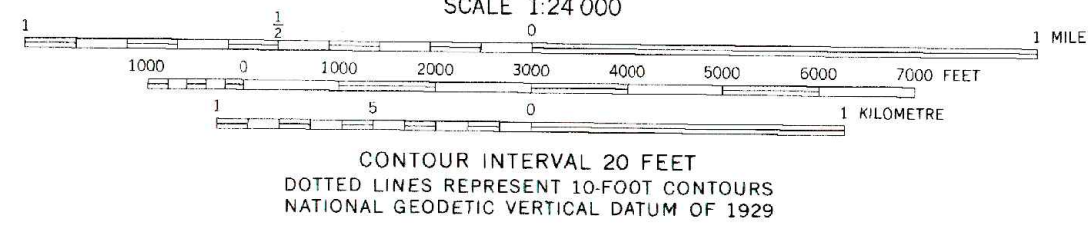
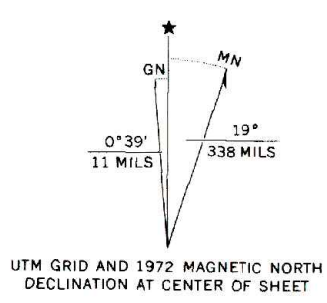
1000-metre Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks,
