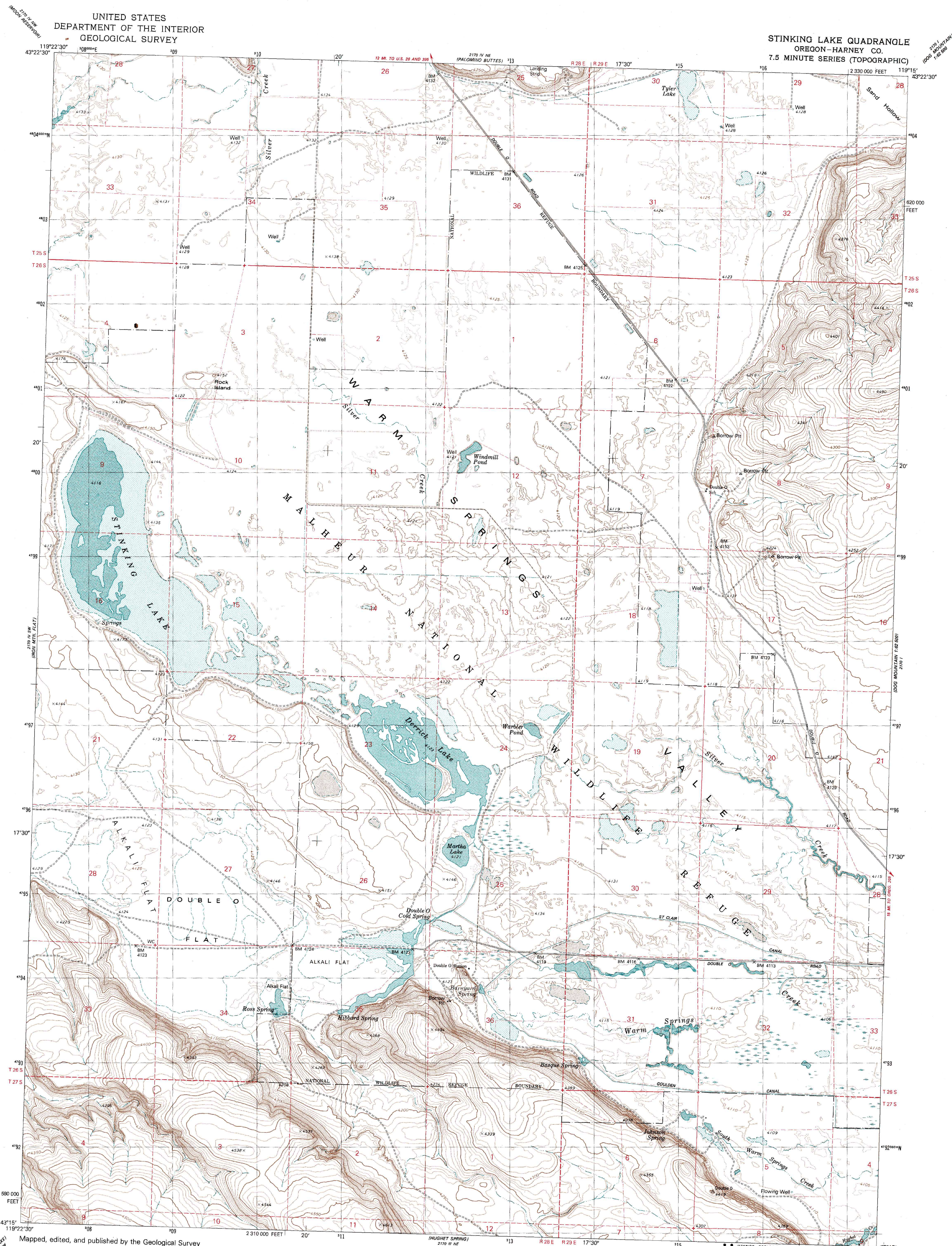
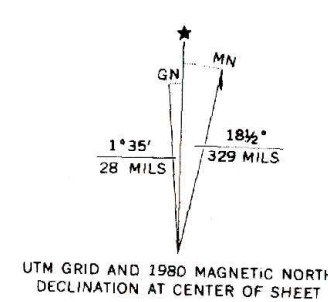

To place on the predicted North American Datum 1983 move the projection lines 18 meters north and 85 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks
Areas covered by dashed light-blue pattern are subject to controlled inundation
There may be private inholdings within the boundaries of the National or State reservations shown on this map
