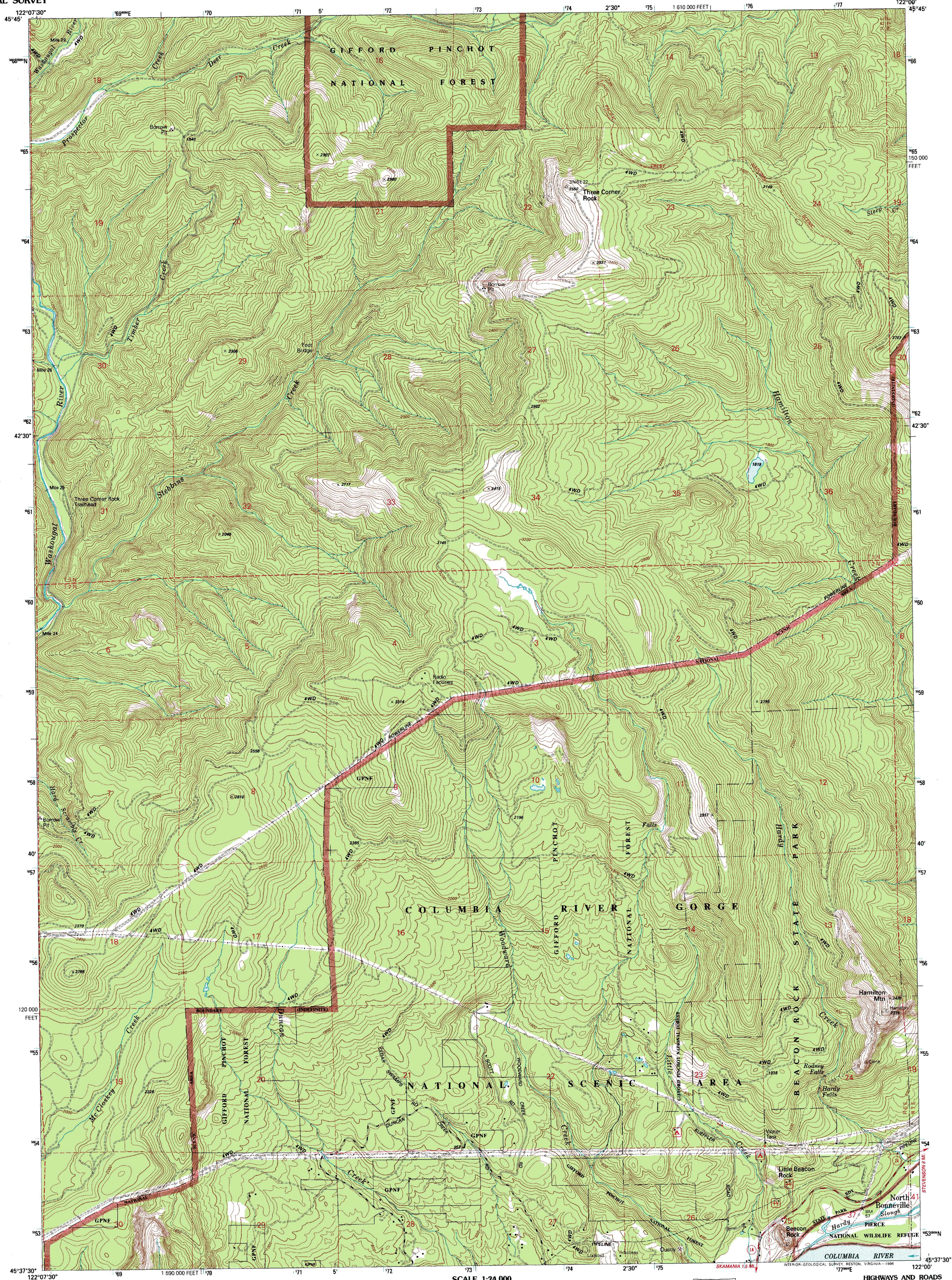

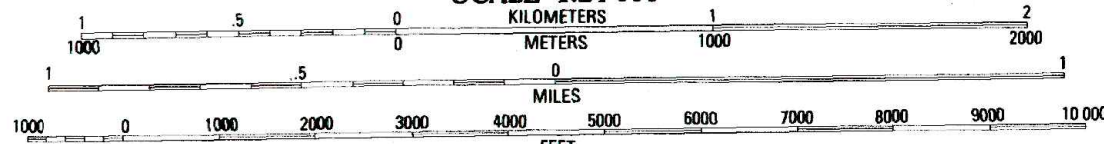
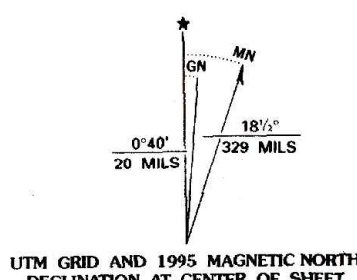
Blue 1000-meter Universal Transverse Mercator ticks, zone 10.
