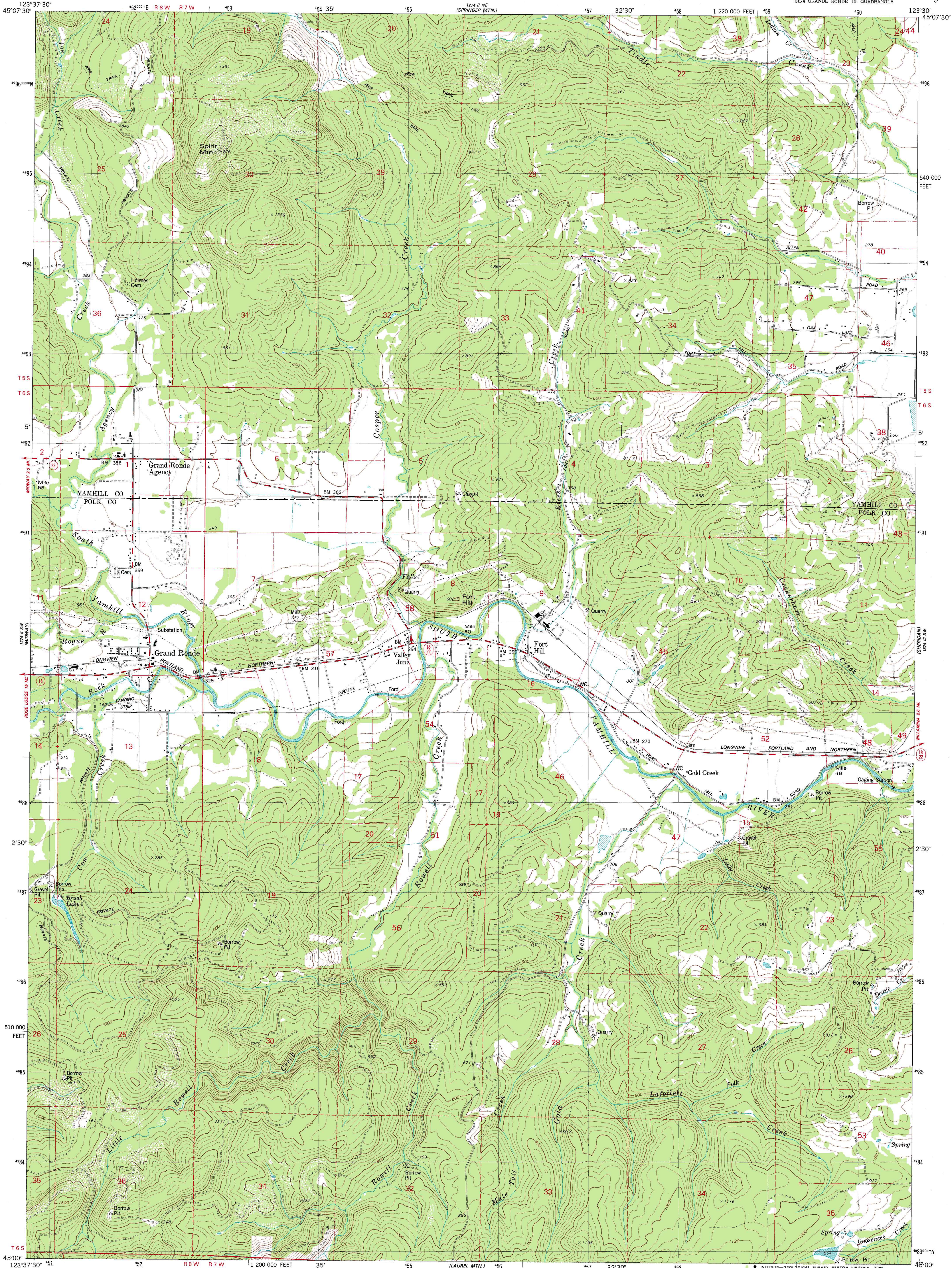

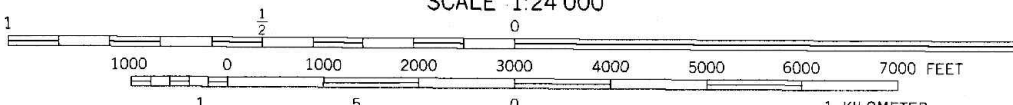
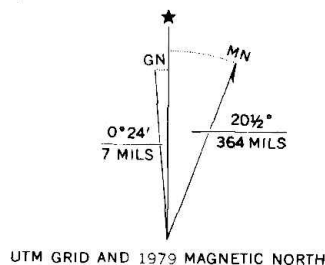

96 meters east as shown by dashed corner ticks

where generally visible on aerial photographs
