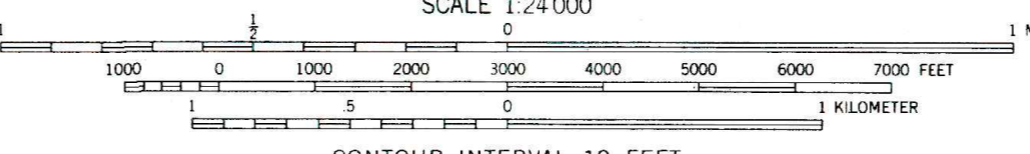
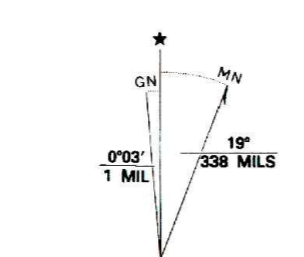
100-meter Universal Transverse Mercator grid ticks, zone 10, shown in blue

Purple tint indicates extension of urban area
